<b>Eligibility:</b>	Open to all instrumentalists and vocalists, (solo or groups) in Southern Maryland age 18 and under who have not yet graduated from high school

**Guidelines:** Each person or group auditioning should be prepared to perform from memory a selection 5 to 10 minutes in duration demonstrating his or her musical capability. An accompanist will be provided if needed. The selection should be commensurate with a level 4-6 of the Maryland State Music Educators guide for vocalists and instrumentalists and level 6 for pianists.

Applications along with a non-refundable \$10 application fee and bio must be received no later than April 7<sup>th</sup>.
